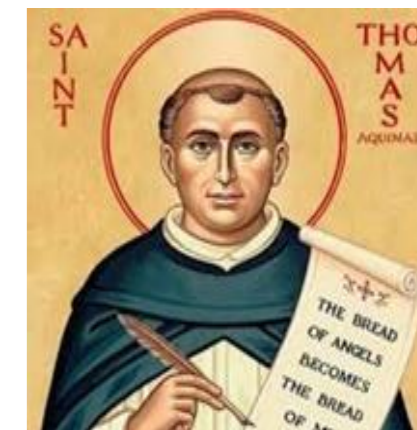

We will pray the Communion Antiphon as printed in the Bulletin and the Walking Together Prayer as a Prayer of Intercession.

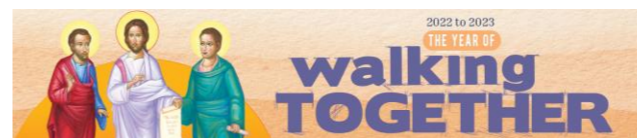
PART-TIME PARISH SECRETARY
