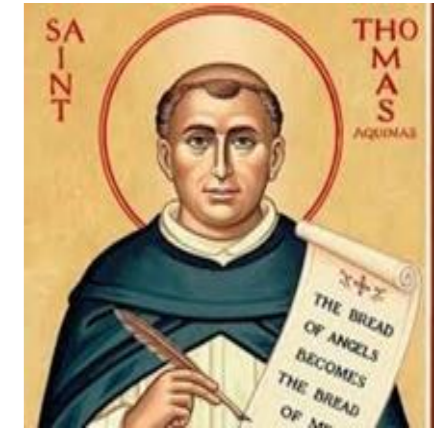

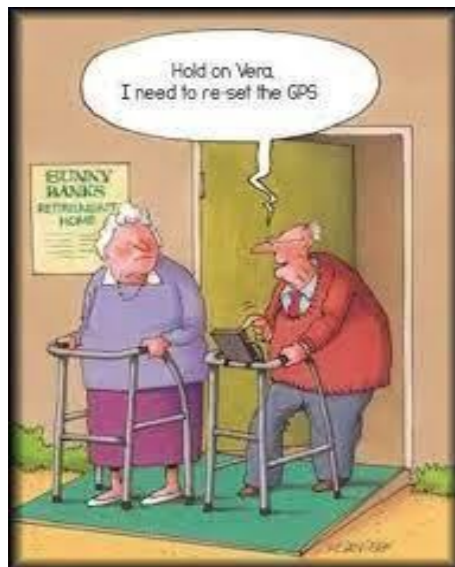

REFLECTION

The Lord's Prayer

In the Gospel text, Christ taught his disciples to pray. Here we have the great prayer of *our father*. This prayer is simple and powerful. Every petition has got great implications for the one who prays it.

Our father: we are all his children, whatever tribe, race, colour, pedigree, rich or poor
Your kingdom come: that is where we belong, the kingdom of peace, love, justice, and blessedness
Your will be done on earth: we are encouraged to truly be opened to accepting his will in our lives

Give us today our daily bread: he knows our material need and he will surely provide

Forgive us our trespasses: this is very important in our relationship with God; we are sinful and weak in need of mercy

As we forgive those who sinned against us: our reception of God's forgiven mercies depends on our ability to forgive others who offend us.

Deliver us from evil: in the midst of evil seen and unseen, we depend on God for protection and great direction in order to survive the many evils that hurt and hunt us daily.

As we pray the Lord's Prayer, we remember grandparents asking God to bless them with fruitfulness in old age.

May the Celebration of this weekend Eucharist help us to make prayers part of our life and daily living.

OUTCOMES OF THE FIFTH PLENARY COUNCIL

277 members of the Plenary Council voted on 30+ motions from the Motions & Amendments document: [\\Camfile01\data\Charnwood Parish\Parish 2022\Archdiocese Manuka\Plenary Council\220714_Report2ndAssembly_Sydney2.pdf](https://www.catholicvoice.org.au/plenary-council-report-archbishop-christopher-prowse/) The voting was staged over two rounds – the consultative & deliberative votes. Results of the voting may be found at: <https://plenarycouncil.catholic.org.au/> By November the Australian Bishops will forward to Rome the final document reflecting the Plenary decisions. In due course, with deliberation & consultation, they will be returned to Australia where they will become law for the Australian Catholic Church.
