

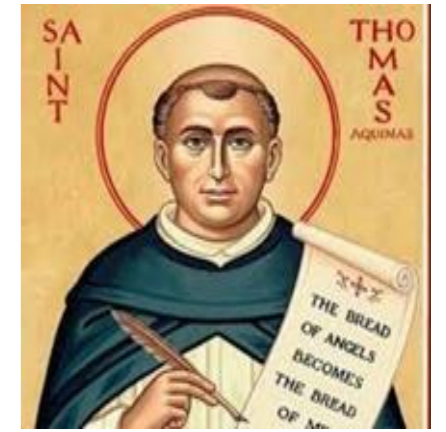

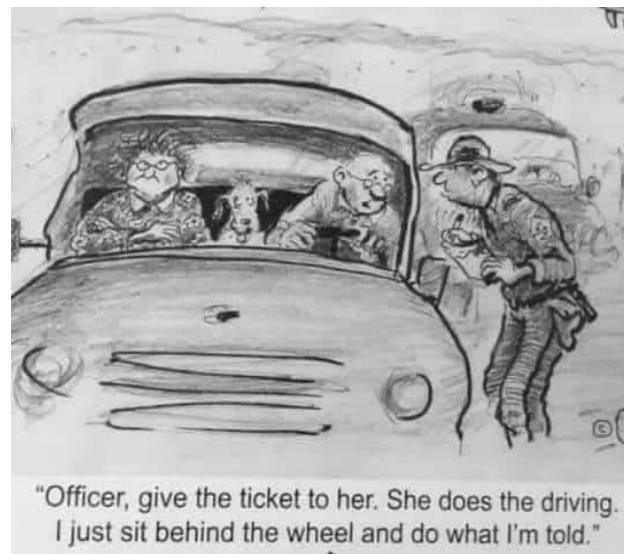

REFLECTION

Pentecost – Celebrating the Feast of the Holy Spirit and Birthday of the Church

Fifty days after Easter, we celebrate the solemnity of Pentecost marking the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles in Jerusalem and the birth(day) of the Church. For seven weeks we have been journeying to this day and, while the Easter season has come to an end yet for the Church, and her members, it is the beginning. The Church's birth and the beginning of her Mission to the world.

Following his baptism, the descent of the Holy Spirit upon him like the dove, and his temptations in the wilderness, Jesus began his public ministry of teaching, preaching, and healing with the power of the Holy Spirit (Lk 4.18-19).

Similarly, the liturgy of the word this weekend (Acts 2:1-11; Ps 104:1, 24, 29-31, 34; 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13; Jn 20:19-23) focuses on how the Church, began with the feast of the Holy Spirit empowering her with the grace to fulfil her mission of bearing witness to Christ in the world beginning from Jerusalem. The task and life of the Church are the same as those of Jesus: bringing God's kingship to its fulfilment through healing, joy, love, and peace – a peace the world cannot give.

May the fire of the Holy Spirit warm our hearts for mission during this winter and always.
