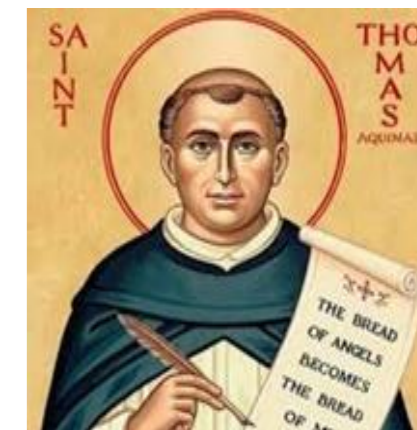

Fr Gerard will move into the Presbytery Wednesday 11 January.

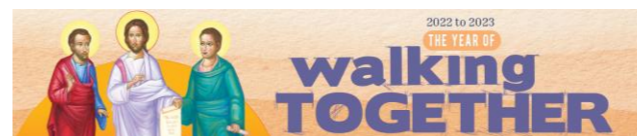
